ORDER

Reg. Implementation of Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Act, 2015.

As you are aware that new Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Act, 2015 has come in force since January, 2016 and thereafter Govt. of India has notified Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Model Rules, 2016 which was applicable from September, 2016.

In this regard, time and again the department had issued several instructions to all the Superintendents of Child Care Institutions to ensure that all the standards of care are maintained and create a child friendly atmosphere in the Institution and also ensure the following:-

- The Superintendents of Child Care Institution are also directed to engage the children in hobby and vocational training classes during their summer holidays so as to channelize their energy in constructive ways.
- The Superintendents shall also regularly convene the meetings of Management Committee and Children's Committee as prescribed under the Act.
- All the children between the age of 6-14 yrs. should be enrolled in regular schools in compliance to provision of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009.
- The children who are out of school should be engaged in non-formal education, skill development programme and life skill education.
- Mental Health interventions, including counseling specific to the needs of the children must be the priority of the CCI.
- The children should be motivated towards recreational activities including sports and cultural activities.
- The Superintendents shall ensure that the case management including preparation and follow up of Individual Care Plan of each child housed in CCIs be prepared by W.O. and is regularly updated.
- Any other service that may reasonably be provided in order to ensure the well-being of the child.
- The daily schedule of activities of the inmates should also be displayed on the notice board at the prominent location inside the institution, preferably the schedule may be painted on the wall.

- 10. The duly deployment chart of the staff should also be displayed on the prominent place near the Superintendent's office on a white board/black board. This is as per instructions of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide order dt. 14.02.20014. In case there is any absenteeism/replacement, the same should be visible on the board to all the inspecting officers.
- 11. The weekly menu of food provided to the inmates should be painted/pasted on the wall of the dining area/near the kitchen in bold letters. The nutrition and diet scale must be adhered to.
- 12. The numbers of nearest hospital/ambulance/fire station should be written after practical checking of the numbers. All the staff including the Welfare Officers and Care Takers on duty at night may be apprised of these numbers.
- 13. The Superintendents should ensure that clothing, bedding, toiletries and other articles shall be provided to each resident as per the scale and climatic conditions.
- Proper segregation of Garbage.
- 15. Sensitization of staff and children on usage of electricity and water.

All the Superintendents are directed to give compliance report on each point on monthly basis.

By endorsing a copy of this order to all the CWCs, the department is requesting the Chairperson, CWCs to comply with Section 30 (viii) of the aforesaid Act to oversee the functioning of all the CCIs twice a month.
