Minutes of the Meeting of the State Level Selection Committee held on 02.03.2017 & 03.03.2017 at 10:30 onwards in Department of Women & Child Development for the Selection of Member Social Worker, Juvenile Justice Boards.

The meeting of State Level Selection Committee was held on 02.03.2017 & 03.03.2017 to select and recommend the eligible candidates for the post of Member Social Worker, Juvenile Justice Boards.

In order to fill in the vacancies (both existing and prospective) in the Juvenile Justice Boards, by way of conducting interviews of eligible candidates, the Govt. of NCT of Delhi has under notification F. No. 61(998)/Constitution of SLSC/DD(CPU)/DWCD/2016/37381-394 dt. 15.02.2017 constituted a Selection Committee under Rule 87 of the Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Model Rules, 2016. The Selection Committee comprising the following had been notified.

1. The Selection Committee presided over by Justice Hon'ble Sunita Gupta, (Retired) Delhi High Court Judge, conducted interviews for selection of Member Social Worker, Juvenile Justice Boards.

2. The Director, WCD being the Member Secretary, SLSC briefed the Committee about the role, selection process, functions and honorarium paid to the Member Social Worker, Juvenile Justice Boards. The Committee was informed about the vacancy position of JJBs i.e. urgent requirement of four candidates out of which two shall be women for JJB-I & II. The Committee was also requested to recommend a panel of names which shall be utilized in future as and when vacancy arises in JJBs or to constitute proposed new JJB at Narela. The panel shall be valid for a period of one year from the date of recommendation.

3. The Member Secretary also informed the Committee that as per Act & Rule, a person to be selected as Member Social Worker of the Board shall have at least seven years experience of working with children in the field of Education, Health or Welfare activities or should be a practicing professional with a degree in child psychology or psychiatry or sociology or in the field of law.
4. The Committee was informed that department has received 112 applications for the said post out of which 49 candidates were shortlisted on the basis of educational criteria as well as experience that has already been spelt out under the Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Act, 2015 & the Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Model Rules, 2016.
5. The Committee assessed the following 44 short listed candidates which were present for the interview.
