1. Brief facts of the complaint

The complainant has filed a complaint stating that hils son Prathush G.N., aged 23 years had been contacted by some unknown person and introduced himself as Sam and sometimes introduced as Ginder. The person created a fake account in Whatsapp and facebook in the name of his son and his mobile number, where nonsense items/messages are placed. He also alleged that he sends regular text messages and vulgar messages on his mobile number t hrough Whatsapps. When his son contacted him and requested not to send him these types messages, he refused and threatened him to meet him. Earlier he used to send the vulgar messages from mobile nos. 8285748620 and 9711461867 but now a days he also uses mobile nos. 9720305497 and 8077022165. He made a complaint to PS Mukherjee Nagar on 8.6.2017 and another complaint was forwarded to Jt. C.P. on 15.6.2017, but till date no action has been taken by PS Mukherjee Nagar and the culprit is still misusing the name of his son and regularly sending the text messages and vulgar images/photos to his son. His son is in depression and trauma. The complainant has requested for legal action in the matter.

2. Proceedings in the Public Grievances Commission

The PGC convened its first hearing in the complaint on 7th December, 2017, the second hearing held on 15th February, 2018 and the third hearing held on 15th March, 2018,, when the following were present:-
