**1. Brief facts of the complaint**

The complainant has filed a complaint against IO Man Mohan Ahuja and SHO PS Rani Bagh for not registering her case under appropriate sections and threatening her to implicate her in false cases if she did not take back her complaint against the vehicle owner Vijay Ahuja. She has further alleged that the alleged person (Vehicle Owner) is a relative of the IO due to which he was pressurizing the complainant to take back her complaint. She has requested for legal action in the matter.

**2. Proceedings in the Public Grievances Commission**

The PGC convened its first hearing in the complaint on 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2017, the second hearing held on 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2018 and the third hearing held on 15<sup>th</sup> March, 2018, when the following were present:-

**3 Relevant facts emerging during the hearing**
