## 1. Brief facts of the Appeal

Ms. Sunita Grover, filed Form-A with the Competent Authority i.e. Special Secretary (Services), Services Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, during November, 2017 under the Delhi Right to Information Act 2001, making queries on total 03 counts.

Ms. Sunita Grover did receive a response from the Competent Authority, however, being aggrieved with the same, she filed an appeal in January, 2018 before the Appellate Authority/ PGC, under Section 7 of the Delhi Right to Information Act, 2001.

3. Relevant facts emerging during the hearing

3.1 At today's hearing on 19/03/2018, representative of the department submitted that a revised

reply dated 16.03.2018, had already been sent to the appellant (copy of the same available

in the file).

3.2 The reply furnished by the department has been perused and it is found that the

department has provided satisfactory information to the queries raised by the appellant in

her DRTI application.

4. <u>Directions of the Appellate Authority / PGC</u>

4.1 Since the department has provided satisfactory reply to the queries of the appellant, hence

the appeal under Delhi Right to Information Act-2001 is closed.

4.2 However, as per the information provided by the Services Department, it appears that the

matter of granting ACP/MACP to the employees of few autonomous Bodies redeployed in the

Government of NCT of Delhi, is pending for a long time.

4.3 The matter is brought to the knowledge of Secretary (Services) with the advise to

personally look into the issue and formulate the policy at the earliest, preferably within 3

months from the date of issue of this Order.

4.4 An Action Taken Report on the advise of this Commission as mentioned above may be

provided to the Commission for perusal.

With the above observations / directions, the present appeal case is ordered to be

disposed of before the Appellate Authority / Member (PGC).
