1. Brief facts of the Appeal

Shri Naresh Chaudhary filed Form-A during June, 2017, with the Competent Authority under Delhi Right to Information Act, 2001, i.e. Deputy Director of Education (District South), Directorate of Education, making queries on total 4 counts.

Shri Naresh Chaudhary did not receive any response from the Office of Deputy Director of Education (District South), Directorate of Education. Hence, he filed an Appeal during July, 2017, before the Appellate Authority / PGC, under Section 7 of the Delhi Right to Information Act, 2001.

2. Proceedings in the Public Grievances Commission
