**1. Brief facts of the Appeal**

Shri R. L. Makhija filed Form-A during June, 2017, under the Delhi RTI Act, 2001, with the Competent Authority i.e. Director (Personnel), North DMC, seeking information on total 10 counts.

Shri R. L. Makhija did receive a response from the Office of Director (Personnel), North DMC. However, being aggrieved with the same, he filed an Appeal during August, 2017, before the Appellate Authority / PGC, under Section 7 of the Delhi Right to Information Act, 2001.

**2. Proceedings in the Public Grievances Commission**

The PGC has convened its first hearing on 1<sup>st</sup> March, 2018. At the hearing on 01/03/2018, the attendance was as follows :

**3. Relevant facts emerging during the hearing**

3.1 At the hearing on 01/03/2018, respondent not present. The reply furnished by the Competent Authority vide letter dated 26.07.2017 (copy available in the file) was perused.

3.2 On perusal of the reply, it has been observed that the department had provided satisfactory information in respect of the queries posed by the appellant in his application under DRTI Act-2001.

**4. Directions of the PGC**

The Appellate Authority / Member, PGC is of the view that all the queries posed by the appellant, have been satisfactorily answered by the Competent Authority under Delhi RTI Act, 2001 and as such, the substance of the present appeal under Delhi RTI Act, 2001 has been met.
