## 1. Brief facts of the Appeal

Shri Vikal Singh filed Form-A during October, 2017, under the Delhi RTI Act, 2001, with the Competent Authority i.e. Deputy Director of Education (North East), Directorate of Education, making gueries on total 30 counts.

Shri Vikal Singh did receive a response from the Office of Deputy Director of Education (North East), Directorate of Education, but he was not satisfied with the same. Hence, he filed an Appeal during December, 2017, before the Appellate Authority / PGC, under Section 7 of the Delhi Right to Information Act, 2001.

## 2. <u>Proceedings in the Public Grievances Commission</u>

The PGC convened its first hearing on 12<sup>th</sup> March, 2018. At today's hearing on 12/03/2018, the attendance was as follows:

3. Relevant facts emerging during the hearing

3.1 At today's hearing on 12/03/2018, representative of the department submitted that a

reply had already been sent to the appellant vide letter dated 17/11/2017. A copy of the same

is available in the file.

3.2 On perusal of the reply furnished by the department, it has been observed that the reply

is not signed by the Competent Authority, and hence not acceptable. Further in respect of

query No. 1, the department informed that they are bound to disclose those information which

are maintained as per DSEAR-1973 and the Master Register is not maintained as per DSEAR-

1973 and hence can not be provided. In respect of remaining queries i.e. 2 to 30, the answer is

N.A..

3.3 As per Delhi Education Act and Rules, it is mandatory for the privae schools to provide

certain information on a periodic basis to the Directorate of Education. Competent Authority is

directed to provide pointwise information in respect of all the queries raised by the appellant in

his DRTI Act. Competent Authority is durther directed to clarify in his reply whether it is

mandatory for the Directorate of Education, to maintain the ifnformation, as asked by the

appellant, as per Delhi Education Act & Rules.

4. <u>Directions of the Appellate Authority / PGC</u>

4.2. The Competent Authority i.e. Dy. Director of Education (North-East) is directed to

furnish a revised reply, as advised in para 3.2 and 3.3 above the appellant within

10 days from the date of issue of this order, with a copy to the Commission. The

reply should be furnished to the appellant under the signatures of Competent

Authority, properly stamped, having the name of the Competent Authority

(documents, if any, appended with the reply should be certified either by the

Competent Authority or an official deputed by the Competent Authority).

Accordingly, the appeal case is ordered to be disposed of before the Appellate
