1. Brief facts of the Appeal

Shri R. L. Makhija filed Form-A during May, 2017, under the Delhi RTI Act, 2001, with the Competent Authority i.e. Deputy Commissioner (City S.P. Zone), North DMC, seeking information on total 7 counts.

Shri R. L. Makhija received no response from the Office of Deputy Commissioner (City S.P. Zone), North DMC. Hence, he filed an Appeal during June, 2017, before the Appellate Authority / PGC, under Section 7 of the Delhi Right to Information Act, 2001.

2. Proceedings in the Public Grievances Commission

3. Relevant facts emerging during the hearing
