**1. Brief facts of the Appeal**

Shri R. L. Makhija filed Form-A during May, 2017, under the Delhi RTI Act, 2001, with the Competent Authority i.e. Deputy Commissioner (Civil Lines Zone), North DMC, seeking information on total 14 counts.

Shri R. L. Makhija received no response from the Office of Deputy Commissioner (Civil Lines Zone), North DMC. Hence, he filed an Appeal during June, 2017, before the Appellate Authority / PGC, under Section 7 of the Delhi Right to Information Act, 2001.

**2. Proceedings in the Public Grievances Commission**

**3. Relevant facts emerging during the hearing**
