**1. Brief facts of the Appeal**

Shri R. L. Makhija filed Form-A during July 2017, under the Delhi RTI Act, 2001, with the Competent Authority i.e. Deputy Commissioner (Civil Lines Zone), North DMC, seeking information on total 15 counts.

Shri R. L. Makhija received no response from the Office of Deputy Commissioner (Civil Lines Zone), North DMC. Hence, he filed an Appeal during August, 2017, before the Appellate Authority / PGC, under Section 7 of the Delhi Right to Information Act, 2001.
