1. Brief facts of the Appeal

Shri Sunil Kumar Sharma filed Form-A during December, 2017, under the Delhi RTI Act, 2001, with the Competent Authority i.e. Deputy Commissioner (City SP Zone), North DMC, seeking information on total 3 counts.

Shri Sunil Kumar Sharma received no response from the Office of Deputy Commissioner (City SP Zone), North DMC. Hence, he filed an Appeal during January, 2018, before the Appellate Authority / PGC, under Section 7 of the Delhi Right to Information Act, 2001.

2. <u>Proceedings in the Public Grievances Commission</u>

The Public Grievances Commission convened its first hearing on 16th April, 2018. At today's hearing, the attendance was as follows:

3. Relevant facts emerging during the hearing

3.1 At today's hearing on 16/04/2018, Shri Mohd. Shakil, AE (Building), City SP Zone,

submitted a copy of letter dated 07/02/2018, vide which requisite information has been

sent to the appellant.

3.2 The information furnished by the department has been perused. In query no. 1, the

appellant is seeking the list of properties sanctioned in the year 2017 under 'Saral

Scheme'. However, the department has informed that the requisite information is

voluminous in nature and will divert the available resources of this office, as no specific

property number has been mentioned in the DRTI application. It has further been

mentioned that the applicant may inspect the available record on 20/02/2018, in the

office of the EE (Building), CSP Zone, North DMC.

3.3 The Appellate Authority / PGC feels that the information furnished by the department is

not appropriate. The appellant is only seeking the list of properties, which should not be

voluminous in nature as mentioned by the department. The number / list of such

properties must be readily available in the department and should be made available to

the appellant.

4. <u>Directions of the Appellate Authority / PGC</u>

4.1 The Competent Authority shall send a revised reply to the appellant within 2 weeks of

issue of this order, under intimation to this Commission, clearly mentioning the number of

such properties sanctioned in the year 2017 under the 'Saral Scheme'. If the same is

available on the website of the department, then address of the website alongwith clear

linkages to the same, must be intimated so that the appellant can easily access the

information.

4.2 The revised reply should be furnished to the appellant under the signatures of Competent

Authority, properly stamped, having the name of the Competent Authority (documents, if

any, appended with the reply should be certified either by the Competent Authority or an

official deputed by the Competent Authority).

With the above direction, the appeal case is ordered to be disposed of before the

Appellate Authority / PGC.
