## 1. Brief facts of the Appeal

respect of query no. 1, it will be sufficient if the department simply mentions the number

of intimation letters that have been received in the office of Deputy Commissioner (Civil

Lines Zone), North DMC, from the Police Department regarding unauthorized

constructions.

4.2 The reply should be furnished to the appellant under the signatures of Competent

Authority, properly stamped, having the name of the Competent Authority (documents, if

any, appended with the reply should be certified either by the Competent Authority or an

official deputed by the Competent Authority).

With the above direction, the appeal case is ordered to be disposed of before the

Appellate Authority / PGC.
