**1. Brief facts of the Appeal**

Shri Sunil Kumar Sharma filed Form-A during December, 2017, under the Delhi RTI Act, 2001, with the Competent Authority i.e. Deputy Commissioner (CLZ), North DMC, seeking information on total 2 counts.

Shri Sunil Kumar Sharma received no response from the Office of Deputy Commissioner (CLZ), North DMC. Hence, he filed an Appeal during January, 2018, before the Appellate Authority / PGC, under Section 7 of the Delhi Right to Information Act, 2001.

**2. Proceedings in the Public Grievances Commission**

The Public Grievances Commission convened its first hearing on 16<sup>th</sup> April, 2018. At today's hearing, the attendance was as follows :

**3. Relevant facts emerging during the hearing**

3.1 At today's hearing on 16/04/2018, although Shri V.N.Roy, OI (Building), CLZ, NDMC, was present on behalf of the department, but he did not file any reply. He however, assured that the requisite information shall be furnished to the appellant, within one week from the date of hearing i.e. 16/04/2018.

**4. Directions of the Appellate Authority / PGC**

4.1 **The Competent Authority i.e. Deputy Commissioner (Civil Lines Zone), North DMC, shall ensure that the requisite information is furnished to the appellant within one week, as assured by the departmental representative in the hearing today.** In respect of query no. 1, it will be sufficient if the department simply mentions the number of intimation letters that have been received in the office of Deputy Commissioner (Civil Lines Zone), North DMC, from the Police Department regarding unauthorized constructions.

4.2 The reply should be furnished to the appellant under the signatures of Competent Authority, properly stamped, having the name of the Competent Authority (documents, if any, appended with the reply should be certified either by the Competent Authority or an official deputed by the Competent Authority).

With the above direction, **the appeal case is ordered to be disposed of before the Appellate Authority / PGC.**
