### 1. Background:

Sh. R.L. Makhija, the appellant vide his four applications dated 21.08.2017 under Delhi Right to Information Act, 2001, had sought information from the Competent Authority notified under the DRTI Act-2001 on total 11 queries.

The appellant did not receive any information from the Competent Authority i.e. Deputy Commissioner (Keshav Puram Zone) of North DMC. Hence, he filed the appeals before the Appellate Authority, Public Grievances Commission under Section 7 of DRTI Act -2001.

## 2. Proceedings

The appellant is present. Shri K.R. Meena, A.E. (B), K.P. Zone, NDMC present on behalf of the respondent / Competent Authority. The appellant as well as respondent informed that no notice has been received by them regarding this particular appeal case and hence they do not have the requisite information related to the appeal case.

On perusal of record, it is evident that a reply dated 21.09.2017 has been furnished by the department, however, the same is not satisfactory and incomplete, hence not accepted by the Appellate Authority.

#### 3. Decision:

The Competent Authority i.e. Deputy Commissioner (Keshav Puram Zone) is directed to furnish the point-wise reply to the queries of the appellant within 2 weeks from the date of issue of this order, directly to the appellant, with a copy to the Appellate Authority.

The reply should be furnished to the appellant under the signatures of Competent Authority, properly stamped, having the name of Competent Authority. Documents, if any, appended with the reply should be certified either by the Competent Authority or an official deputed by the Competent Authority, free of cost.

The matter is accordingly disposed of at the Commission's end.
