### **Background**

The appellant has stated that the Competent Authority has not provided the information as asked for vide his application dated 22.02.2017 (Ref. RLM/2016-17/177 dated 20.2.2017). Being aggrieved with the same he filed the appeal before the Commission.

# **Proceedings**

The appellant present and heard. None present on behalf of the Competent Authority.

The Commission vide its order dated 31.05.2017, had directed the Competent Authority to ensure replies to the queries of the appellant within 3 weeks from the date of receipt of this order. Again, neither any representative of the Competent Authority is present nor any information has been furnished to the appellant.

#### **Decision**

The above acts and omissions clearly attribute pathetic approach of the Competent Authority towards his duties and responsibilities under the Delhi Right to Information Act-200 and shall be construed as denial of information and obstruction in the free flow of information. Particularly, when the Competent Authority has been directed / informed vide order dated 20.11.2017.

The Competent Authority i.e. Director (Personnel) North DMC is directed to explain the undue delay in furnishing the requisite information in person or through an unauthorized representative, within 2 weeks. This shall be treated as the last opportunity granted under Section 7 (3) of the Delhi Right to Information Act-2001, failing which a final decision shall be passed by the Commission.
