1. Brief facts of the Appeal

Sh. Shailander Kumar filed Form-A during November, 2017, under the Delhi RTI Act, 2001, with the Competent Authority i.e. Deputy Commissioner (Civil Lines Zone), North DMC, seeking information on total 6 counts.

Sh. Shailander Kumar received no response from the Office of Deputy Commissioner (Civil Lines Zone), North DMC. Hence, he filed an Appeal during January, 2018, before the Appellate Authority / PGC, under Section 7 of the Delhi Right to Information Act, 2001.

2. Proceedings in the Public Grievances Commission

The PGC convened its first hearing on 14th May, 2018, and the following were present:

Appellant : Absent

Respondent: Sh. Naresh Kumar, LDC, Civil Lines Zone, North DMC

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3. Relevant facts emerging during the hearing

3.1 During the hearing on 14/05/2018, appellant was not present. Sh. Naresh Kumar, LDC,

Civil Lines Zone, North DMC stated that a reply had already been sent to the appellant vide

letter dated 10.05.2018. He submitted a copy of the same before the Appellate Authority /

Member (PGC).

3.2 On perusal of information furnished, it has been observed that the department had

informed the appellant that the information asked cannot be supplied as per Section 6(B) of

Delhi Right to Information Act-2001.

3.3 However, on perusal of information asked by the appellant, it has been observed that

though information in respect of Query Nos. 3, 4 & 6 cannot be provided but information of

query No. 1, 2 and 5 can be provided.

3.4 In respect of Query No. 1, name of allottee should be provided to the appellant. In

respect of Query No. 2 only amount deposited should be provided. In respect of Query No. 5,

only details of penalty should be provided. In respect of Query No. 6, appellant may allow to

inspect the postage register, if he asked for the same.

4. <u>Directions of the Appellate Authority / PGC</u>

4.1 Competent Authority i.e. Deputy Commissioner (Civil Lines Zone) is directed to furnish a

revised reply to the appellant, as advised in para 3.4 above, within 15 days from the date of

receipt of this order, with a copy to the Commission.

4.2 The reply should be furnished to the appellant under the signatures of Competent

Authority, properly stamped, having the name of the Competent Authority (documents, if any,

appended with the reply should be certified either by the Competent Authority or an official

deputed by the Competent Authority).

With the above observations / directions, the present appeal case is ordered to be

closed before the Appellate Authority / Member (PGC).
