1. Brief facts of the Appeal

Shri Wahid Khan sought information, during December, 2017, from the Competent Authority under Delhi RTI Act, 2001, i.e Special Commissioner (Administration), Department of Food, Supplies & Consumer Affairs, making queries on total 5 counts.

Shri Wahid Khan did not receive a reply from the Office of Special Commissioner (Administration), Department of Food, Supplies & Consumer Affairs. Hence, he filed an Appeal during January, 2018, before the Appellate Authority / PGC, under Section 7 of the Delhi Right to Information Act, 2001.

2. Proceedings in the Public Grievances Commission

The PGC has convened its first hearing on 7th May, 2018. At the hearing on 07/05/2018, the attendance was as follows:

3. Relevant facts emerging during the hearing

- 3.1 At today's hearing on 07.05.2018, representative of the department informed that a reply had already been provided to the appellant vide letter dated 16.04.2018. He submitted a copy of the same before the Appellate Authority / Member (PGC). Copy placed in the file.
- 3.2 The reply furnished by the department has been perused that the department had provided satisfactory information in respect of Query Nos. 1, 4 & 5 hence no further action is required in the matter.
- 3.3 In respect of Query No. 2, the reply is not acceptable since the Policy regarding allotment of FPS to Cooperative Societies must be available with the Headquarter and the same should be provided to the appellant.
- 3.4 In respect of Query No. 3, the appellant is advised to file a fresh application with the Competent Authority i.e. Assistant Commissioner of the concerned District.

4. Directions of the Appellate Authority / PGC

- 4.1 Competent Authority i.e. Special Commissioner (Admn.), F&s Department is directed to furnish a revised reply in respect of Query No. 2, to the appellant within 15 days from the date of receipt of this order, with a copy to the Commission. The reply should be furnished under the signature of Competent Authority.

With the above observations / directions the present appeal case is ordered to be closed before the Appellate Authority / Member (PGC)
