1. Brief facts of the Appeal

Shri Wahid Khan sought information, during January, 2017, from the Competent Authority under Delhi RTI Act, 2001, i.e Deputy Commissioner (Shahdara North Zone), East Delhi Municipal Corporation, making queries on total 5 counts.

Shri Wahid Khan did not receive any reply from the Office of Deputy Commissioner (Shahdara North Zone), East Delhi Municipal Corporation. Hence, he filed an Appeal during February, 2017, before the Appellate Authority / PGC, under Section 7 of the Delhi Right to Information Act, 2001.

2. Proceedings in the Public Grievances Commission

The PGC has so far convened three hearings on 3rd May, 2017, 17th August, 2017 and 19th April, 2018. At the hearing on 19/04/2018, the attendance was as follows :

3. Relevant facts emerging during the hearing

3.1 At the last hearing held on 17/08/2017, the directions of PGC were as follows:

“Since the department has furnished satisfactory information in respect of query nos. 1, 3, 4 & 5, no further action is required to be taken on these points.

In respect of query no. 2, the Competent Authority shall take action as advised at para 3.5 above and furnish an Action Taken Report on the next date of hearing.

The reply should be furnished to the appellant under the signatures of Competent Authority, properly stamped, having the name of the Competent Authority (documents, if any, appended with the reply should be certified either by the Competent Authority or an official deputed by the Competent Authority).

A senior representative shall be deputed to attend the next hearing in this appeal case, with an Action Taken Report (in duplicate)”.

3.2 At today’s hearing on 19/04/2018, representative of the department informed that the protection provided to the property under the relevant provisions of National Capital Territory of Delhi (Special Provisions Act)-2014 has been further extended till 31st December, 2020.

4. Directions of the PGC

Competent Authority i.e, Deputy Commissioner (Shahdara North Zone) is directed that the information regarding extension of protection to the property should be furnished to the appellant within 15 days from the date of receipt of this Order, with a copy to the Commission.

With the above directions / observations, the present appeal case is ordered to be disposed off before the Appellate Authority / Member (PGC).
