1. Brief facts of the Appeal

Shri Anil Dutt Sharma sought information, during May, 2017, from the Competent Authority under Delhi RTI Act, 2001, i.e Deputy Commissioner (City S.P.Zone), North DMC, seeking information on total 13 queries.

Shri Anil Dutt Sharma did not receive a reply from the Office of Deputy Commissioner (City S.P. Zone), North DMC. Hence, he filed an Appeal during June, 2017, before the Appellate Authority / PGC, under Section 7 of the Delhi Right to Information Act, 2001.

2. Proceedings in the Public Grievances Commission

The PGC has so far convened two hearings on 21st December, 2017 and 19th April, 2018. At the hearing on 19.04.2018, the attendance was as follows :

3. Relevant facts emerging during the hearing

- 3.1 At today's hearing on 19.04.2018, the appellant was absent. An e-mail was received in the department at 13.42 hrs from the appellant, requesting for adjournment of the case on the ground that he is busy in Karkardooam Court. However, by that time the hearing in the appeal case had been completed.
- 3.2 Representative of the department submitted that a reply had already been sent to the appellant vide office letter dated 14.06.2017. He submitted a copy of the same before the Appellate Authority / Member (PGC).
- 3.3 On perusal of the reply, it has been observed that the department has provided satisfactory information in respect of all the queries raised by the appellant in his DRTI application.

4. Directions of the Appellate Authority / PGC

Since the department has provided satisfactory reply to the queries of the appellant, no further action needs to be taken in this regard. Accordingly, the present appeal case is ordered to be disposed of before the Appellate Authority / Member (PGC).
