Since the parties involved in the Appeals are common, both the Appeals are being clubbed together for hearing and disposal to avoid multiplicity of the proceedings and effective adjudication.

#### 1 Background:

The appellant vide DRTI application dated 26.3.2018 has sought information on total 22 points each. Aggrieved by non receipt of any information from the Competent Authority, he filed these instant appeals.

#### 2 Proceedings

The appellant is present. Sh. Anurag Manohar, JE (Bldg.) K.P.Zone is present on behalf of the department. The representative of the department has furnished a copy of the reply dt. 9.5.2018 vide which point-wise reply has been sent to the appellant. The reply has been perused and it is observed the department has requested the appellant to inspect the records available with the department and take photocopies of documents required by him.

The appellant was advised to visit the office of the AE (Bldg.) Keshav puram Zone today itself i.e. 30.10.2018 and inspect the relevant records and thereafter obtain photocopies of documents after paying the requisite fee as prescribed under the DRTI Rules 2001. The appellant has agreed for the same and the departmental representative who is present in the hearing also assured that all the relevant documents shall be made available to the appellant for inspection.

#### 3 Decision

The Competent Authority i.e. Dy. Commissioner, Keshav Puram Zone, North DMC shall ensure that inspection of relevant record is accorded to the appellant and thereafter photocopies of documents identified by him shall be made available to him on payment of requisite fees.

With the above directions, the matter is disposed of at the Commission's end.
