### **1 Background :**

The appellant vide DRTI application dated 10.4.2018 has sought information on total 08 points. Aggrieved with non receipt of any information from the Competent Authority, he filed this appeal.

### **2 Proceedings**

The appellant is present. Sh. Diwan Singh, FSO, F&S department is present on behalf of the Competent Authority. The representative of the department informed that the appellant has already been provided point-wise reply by the department vide letter dt. 24.4.2018. He submitted a fresh reply dt. 8.5. 2018 and 14.11.2018.

All the replies of the department have been perused and it is observed that the department has provided satisfactory information to the queries of the appellant. Further in response to query no. 08, the department has informed the appellant that he may inspect the available record on any working day. The departmental representative and the appellant mutually agreed for inspection of the records on 26<sup>th</sup> Nov. 2018 at 3.30 PM in the office of the Asstt. Commissioner, New Delhi District, F&S Department.

### **3 Decision**

Since the department has provided satisfactory information to the appellant in response to his query, except for query no. 08, no further action is required to be taken by the department.

In respect of query no. 08 the Competent Authority viz. Asstt. Commissioner, New Delhi is directed to accord inspection to the appellant on the date and time mutually agreed upon. Thereafter photocopies of documents, if any, identified by the appellant shall be made available to him on payment of requisite fee as prescribed under DRTI Rules 2001.

With the above direction the present appeal case is ordered to be disposed of in the Commission.
