1 Background :

Sh. Kamaljeet Singh, the appellant vide DRTI application dated 27.11.2017 has sought information from the Competent Authority notified under the DRTI Act-2001, on total 14 points.

The appellant did not receive any information from the Competent Authority i.e. the Addl. CEO, DJB. Hence, he filed an appeal before the Appellate Authority, Public Grievances Commission under Section 7 of DRTI Act -2001.

2 Proceedings

The appellant is present. The Officer present on behalf of the department informed that the requisite information has already been provided to the appellant. However, Sh. Kamaljeet Singh denied having received the requisite reply. A copy of the same was provided to him during the course of hearing today. However, the Appellate Authority/PGC notes that the same is not signed by the Competent Authority and hence not acceptable.

The appellant further states that in respect of information pertaining to North Zone, he has inspected the relevant record and also deposited the requisite fees for obtaining photocopies of the documents.

3 Decision

The Officer present from the Central Zone, DJB is directed to allow inspection of relevant records to the appellant, within 15 days of issue of this order. Thereafter photocopy of the documents identified by the appellant shall be provided to him after receipt of requisite fees under the DRTI Rules 2001. An Action Taken Report shall be submitted in this Commission for perusal.

The reply should be furnished to the appellant under the signatures of Competent Authority, properly stamped, having the name of Competent Authority. Documents, if any, appended with the reply should be certified either by the Competent Authority or an official deputed by the Competent Authority.

The matter is accordingly disposed of at the Commission's end.
