## **ORDER**

In pursuance to Cabinet decision No.2721 dated 30.07.2019, Govt. of N.C.T. of Delhi has decided to rationalize the revalidation process and composition fee for Import Permits under Rule 18 of the Delhi Excise Act,2009. It is ordered that henceforth, payment of composition money for extending the validity of Import Permit (IP) based on total IP extension days (including first and second IP revalidation) shall be as under:-

S.No.	No. of days for which extension is required	Revalidation request received within three days for reasons beyond control of licencee	Revalidation request received within 15 days of expiry of IP (% of duty)	Revalidation request received after 15 days & upto 30 days of expiry of IP (% of duty)	Revalidation request received beyond 30 days & upto 90 days of expiry of IP (% of duty)
1	1	Nil /	1%	2%	5%
2	2	Nil	2%	4%	10%
3	3	Nil	3%	6%	15%
4	4	Nil	4%	8%	20%
5	For IP days	Nil	5%	10%	25%

However, each IP revalidation validity will not exceed the number of days permissible as given in original IP. IP revalidation will not be allowed more than two times. Further, revalidation of Import Permit will not be allowed beyond 90 days of its original expiry date unless and otherwise required by some court order.
