Since the parties involved in the Appeals are common, on various Appeals are being clubbed together for hearing and disposal to avoid multiplicity of the proceedings and effective adjudication.

1 Background :

The appellant vide his DRTI applications dated 25.5.2018 has sought information on total 20 points each. Aggrieved by non-receipt of information from the Competent Authority, he filed these appeals.

2 Proceedings

The appellant is not present. Sh. Anurag Sharma, JE (Bldg.), C-SP Zone is present on behalf of the respondent department. He informed that point-wise information, in both the appeal cases, has already been provided to the appellant vide letter dated 11.9.2018. A copy of the same has been submitted in the hearing today.

The reply has been perused and it appears that the department has provided satisfactory information to the queries of the appellant. It is further observed that the department has informed that the property no. L-154 Laxman Puri Nabi Karim has been booked on 24.4.2018 and again on 15.6.2018. Also the property no. L-171, Laxman puri, Nabir Karim has been booked on 4.5.2018 and again booked on 15.6.2018. The departmental representative informed that further action against these properties has also been taken, though the department has not intimated anything in writing. The Dy. Commissioner, C-SP Zone shall furnish an updated status report in respect of the action taken by the department against both the properties, consequent upon the bookings.

3 Decision

Since the Competent Authority viz. Dy. Commissioner City/SP Zone, North DMC has provided satisfactory information to the queries of the appellant, no further action is required to be taken by the department in these two appeal cases.

However, an updated action taken report, as advised above, shall be submitted in the Commission for perusal within 02 weeks receipt of this order.

Accordingly these appeal cases are directed to be disposed of before the Commission.
