1 Background :

The appellant vide his DRTI application dated 23.5.2018 had sought information on total 09 point. Aggrieved by non-receipt of information from the Competent Authority, he filed this appeal.

2. Proceedings

The appellant is present. Sh. M.G. Satya, ARCS and Ms. Geeta Mehta, Asstt. Director (Plg.), O/o RCS are present on behalf of the department. The representative of the department has furnished point-wise reply (in duplicate) to the queries of the appellant vide letter dt. 22.1.2019. A copy of same was handed over to the appellant during the hearing today.

The reply has been perused and it appears that the department has furnished satisfactory reply to the queries of the appellant, except for some points relating to registration certificate, memorandum etc. The departmental representatives suggested that the appellant can visit the office of the RCS and inspect the relevant records. It was mutually decided that the inspection shall be conducted on Monday 4.2.2019 at 11.00 AM.

3 Decision

The Appellate Authority notes that the department has simply submitted documents received from different branches in the Commission today. This cannot be construed as providing proper information. The Competent Authority is informed that it is incumbent upon him to collect the relevant information from all the branches and furnish a point-wise comprehensive information to the appellant, with a copy marked to this Commission.

It is further directed that the Competent Authority shall ensure that the relevant records are made available for inspection to the appellant on the date and time mentioned above. Thereafter photocopies of documents identified by the appellant shall be provided to him on payment of requisite fee as prescribed under DRTI Rules 2001.

With the above directions, the matter is ordered to be disposed of at the Commission's end.
