#### **1** Background :

The appellant vide DRTI application dated 2.5.2018 has sought information on total 02 points. Aggrieved by non-receipt of information from the Competent Authority, he filed this appeal.

## 2 Proceedings

The appellant is not present. Sh. A.K. Jain, AE (Bldg.) CSP Zone, North DMC is present on behalf of the department. The representative of the department informed that point-wise information has already been furnished to the appellant vide letter dt. 21.2.2019. A copy of the same was submitted in the hearing today.

The reply has been perused. The department has provided satisfactory reply in response to query no. 01. In response to query no. 02 regarding inspection of files, the department has stated that the inspection can be carried out only after the files are received from the Headquarter. This reply of the department is vague and hence rejected. There cannot be an indefinite uncertainty of the time period for which the appellant has to wait for inspection of files. Personal efforts must be made to collect the files from Hq. and then inspection shall be allowed to the appellant. The departmental representative agreed that he will take personal initiative in this regard.

## 3 Decision

Since the Competent Authority viz. Dy. Commissioner City/SP Zone, North DMC has provided satisfactory information to query no. 01, no further action is required in response to this query. In response to query no. 02, the Competent Authority is directed to take action as advised above, so that the appellant can inspect the relevant record at the earliest.

An Action Taken Report shall be submitted in the Commission for perusal, preferably within 04 weeks of receipt of this order.

With the above direction, the present appeal case is ordered to be disposed of in this Commission.
