## **1. Background**

Shri Sunil Kumar Sharma, the appellant vide his applications dated 05/06/2018 under Delhi Right to Information Act, 2001, had sought information from the Competent Authority on 3 points. Being aggrieved with non receipt of any information, he filed these appeals before the Commission.

## **2. Proceedings**

The appellant is not present.

Shri K.K. Gupta, AE (B) and Shri V.N.Roy, OI (B), Civil Lines Zone, North DMC, are present on behalf of the Competent Authority.

The departmental representatives informed that a point-wise reply, has already been sent to the appellant vide department's letter dated 12/06/2018. A copy of the same was submitted in the hearing today.

The information furnished by the department has been perused. The department has informed that the information regarding bookings and building plans are available on the website of the North DMC. In response to query nos. 1 & 2, the department has informed that the information sought is voluminous and the appellant can inspect the relevant records on any working day.

### 3. Decision

It appears that the department has provided satisfactory information to the queries of the appellant. It is, however, directed that the relevant records pertaining to the information sought by the appellant in query nos. 1 & 2 shall be made available to him for inspection by the department on any working day. The date and time fixed for inspection shall be intimated to the appellant in writing well in advance. Thereafter, copy of documents, identified by the appellant, after inspection of relevant records, shall be furnished to him, on payment of prescribed fee, in accordance with the provisions of Delhi Right to Information Act & Rules, 2001.

With the above direction, **these appeal cases are ordered to be closed before the Appellate Authority / PGC.**
