1. Brief facts of the complaint

Ms Kamala Anantharaman has filed a petition regarding discrepancies in the fixation of family pension by the SDMC.

2. Proceedings in the Public Grievances Commission

The PGC has convened three hearings in the matter so far and in the hearing held on 08.05.2019, the following are present :-

Complainant : Represented through her son

Respondent : Sh. Mahender Mishra, LDC, SDMC

3. Relevant facts emerging during the hearing

3.1 Sh. Mahender Mishra, LDC, SDMC is present in the hearing and submitted a Status Report stating that :

“late Sh. L. N. Anantharaman, Retd. Vaid having qualifying service of 11.5 years whose Basic Pension at the time of retirement was @ Rs. 103 + DR including NPA. After consolidating his pension as per O. M. dated 28.01.2013 so arrived Enhanced Family Pension Rs. 12675 + DR and Normal Family Pension Rs. 7605 + DR with additional pension as applicable on attaining the age of 80, 85 and 90 years. Consequence, difference of pension arrear w.e.f. 01.01.2006 to 09.10.2006 Rs. 70,821/- for Enhanced Period and w.e.f 10.10.2006 to 31.08.2017 Rs. 4,26,670/- for Normal Family Pension period under 6th CPC has been made. Further,

arrears of family pension will be paid by the pension disbursing bank of the family pensioner.

In view of above, RTGS of Rs. 70,821/- and Rs. 4,26,670/- is under process and same will be credited in family pensioner account shortly. Previous details of payment which is already made to the family pensioner are as under:-

1. Rs. 62,126/- difference of pension arrears for Enhanced Period.
2. Rs. 7,25,146/- difference of pension arrears for Normal Family Pension Period. “

4. Directions of the PGC :

Action in the matter has been taken by the SDMC, matter stands closed at the level of this Commission.
