**Order under Para 2(B) of the PGC Resolution No F.4/14/94-AR**  
**dated 25.9.97**

**1. Brief facts of the complaint**

Sh. Vivek Sharma has filed a grievance in this Commission regarding non release of family pension in favour of his sister Smt. Vandana Dixit, divorced daughter of late Sh. Vishnu Dutt Sharma worked as Asstt. Engineer (Civil), Engineering HQ in unified MCD.

**2. Proceedings in the Public Grievances Commission**

The PGC has convened five hearings in the matter so far and in the hearing held on 04.06.2019, the following are present:

**3. Relevant facts emerging during the hearing**

3.1 Sh. A. K. Singhal, EE (Plg.), North DMC is present in the hearing and submitted a Status Report stating that the matter was referred to Law Department and the Law Department opined being the financial matter the case may be sent to the Finance Department. Further, the DCA (F.P.) has opined that as the case has already been examined under PGC case no. PGC/2015/MCD/1905/25059 dated 20.02.2019, by which the applicant was requested to submit the complete case along with administrative approval, divorce certificate and dependency certificate for grant of family pension in her favour. Further, a

circular No. AO(P)/NDMC/2019/339 dated 03.05.2019 has also been issued for requirement of necessary documents for grant of family pension to unmarried daughter, widow daughter and divorced daughter. The applicant Sh. Vivek Sharma has stated in his representation that divorce papers of Smt. Vandana Dixit are not available.

As per 54(27-A) CCS (Pension) Rule, 1972, decree of divorce is required for grant of family pension. Hence, the applicant has to submit the required documents for grant of family pension.

3.2 The complainant present in the hearing stated that as advised in the last hearing, he tried to get the divorce papers from his sister's husband, but failed to get the same.

#### **4. Directions of the PGC**

The complainant is advised to try to get the divorce papers of Smt. Vandana Dixit and submit the same with the Engineering Planning Department, North DMC to further proceed in the matter for release of Family Pension in favour of his sister, Smt. Vandana Dixit.

With the above directions in the matter the case stands closed in this Commission.
