1 Background:

The appellant vide his DRTI applications dated 8.2.2019 has sought information on total 06 points. Aggrieved by non-receipt of information from the Competent Authority, she filed this appeal.

2 Proceedings

The appellant is not present. Sh. Birpal Singh, AE (MCD) KB Zone North DMC is present on behalf of the respondent department. The representative of the department informed that point-wise information has already been provided to the appellant vide letter dt. 27.3.2019. He submitted a copy of the same in the hearing today.

The reply of the department has been perused and it appears that the department has provided satisfactory information to the appellant in respect of query nos. 1 to 5. In respect of query no. 06 the department has volunteered that the appellant can inspect the relevant records on any working day, since the information sought is voluminous. The Appellate Authority further notes that the appellant has given in writing that he is satisfied with the information provided to him by the department in response to his DRTI application.

3 Decision

Since the Competent Authority viz. Dy. Commissioner, KB Zone has provided satisfactory information to the appellant in respect of his DRTI application and the appellant is also satisfied with the same, no further action is required to be taken by the department.

Accordingly, the present appeal case is ordered to be disposed of in the Commission.
