Since the parties involved in the Appeals are common, various Appeals are being clubbed together for hearing and disposal to avoid multiplicity of the proceedings and effective adjudication.

## **1** Background :

The appellant vide DRTI application dated 14.11.2018 has sought information on total 14 points each. Aggrieved by non receipt of any information from the Competent Authority, he filed these instant appeals.

#### 2 Proceedings

The appellant is not present. Sh. Suraj Prakash, AE (Bldg.) K.B. Zone, North DMC is present on behalf of the department. The representative of the department informed that the information sought by the appellant is voluminous and has volunteered that the appellant can inspect the records. Accordingly the appellant is advised that he may inspect the relevant records in the office of the concerned AE (Bldg.) on any working day between 24.6.2019 and 28.6.2019, between 2.00 PM and 5.00 P.M., with prior intimation to the concerned officer.

The Appellate Authority further notes that, on an earlier date of hearing, the appellant had been advised to inspect the relevant records on 7.6.2019, but the departmental representative has informed that the appellant did not visit the office for inspection of the relevant records. The appellant is accordingly advised that he must visit the office of the Dy. Commissioner, KB Zone for inspection of the records on the date and time mentioned above.

# **3 Decision**

The Competent Authority i.e. Dy. Commissioner, K.B. Zone, North DMC shall ensure that all the relevant records are made available to the appellant for inspection on the date and time mentioned above. Thereafter photocopies of documents identified by the appellant shall be provided to him on payment of requisite fee as prescribed under the DRTI Rules 2001.

With the above direction, all the appeal cases are ordered to be disposed of at the Commission's end.
