1. Background

Shri Vivek Bansal, the appellant, vide his application dated 23/02/2019 under **Delhi Right to Information Act, 2001, had** sought information from the Competent Authority on 07 points. Aggrieved with non-receipt of any reply, he filed this appeal before the Commission.

2. Proceedings

The appellant is present and heard.

Shri Shiv Kumar, A.E., North-West, Road-I PWD and Shri Yogesh Kapoor, AAO, North-West, PWD are present on behalf of the Competent Authority and submitted a reply dated 30.07.2019 before the Appellate Authority relating to information pertaining to North West Road-2 Division. It was further informed that information relating to Road-1 Division has already been sent to the appellant vide letter dated 15/04/2019. A copy of the same was also submitted in the hearing today. A copy of the same was given to the appellant. The appellant stated that he is not satisfied with the information, as he has requested for registration number of the private water tankers engaged / hired by PWD for sprinkling water etc.

Departmental representative submitted that the appellant may inspect their office and peruse the record, as the information asked by the appellant is voluminous in nature.

The appellant may visit the office of Executive Engineer concerned, perused the document and collect the copy of required document, on payment of requisite fees as per DRTI Rules 2001 i.e. Rs. 5/- per page. If the registration number of water tankers is

not available in the record, the department will give in writing that the department is not noting down the registration number of tankers.

3. Decision:

Competent Authority i.e. Chief Engineer (North Zone), Public Works Department shall personally ensure that all the documents will be made available to the appellant during the inspection, by the office of Executive Engineer, NWR-1 and NWR-2.

A revised reply, after inspection by the appellant, shall be furnished to the appellant, under the signature and stamp of the Competent Authority within 15 days from the date of receipt of this order, with a copy marked to the Commission.

With the above directions, the appeal case is ordered to be closed before the Appellate Authority / PGC.
