
Madam/Sir,

Dear Shri Vijay,

You may be aware that the National Voters' Day is being celebrated across the country on 25th January to register the newly eligible young (18+) in the electoral roll and also to promote electoral participation.

2. In keeping with the practice in the past nine years, it is requested that schools and Educational Institutions in your state may be instructed to organize National Voters' Day for infusion of democratic values like debate, declamations, mock polls, drawing and quiz competitions on or during run-up to National Voters' Day with the themes of democracy and electoral participations. The CEO of your State shall facilitate technical inputs for the same.
