**ORDER**

In the review meeting on 06.02.2020 at 4.00 pm by Justice (Retd.) S.P. Garg, head of the NGT appointed MC (Water Bodies), a serious view was taken by the Committee for not undertaking the work of development of Water Bodies in accordance with the timelines given by the I&FC Department in respect of 95 Water Bodies, especially Water Bodies which were to be completed by September, 2020. This is a matter of grave concern and reflects lack of professionalism and negligence on the part of the senior officers who are supposed to complete the work in consonance with the committed timelines.

In order to comply with the orders of Hon'ble NGT issued from time to time with the regard to the development of Water Bodies in a dedicated and time-bound manner, Shri Sanjay Saxena, CE (Zone-II) is, hereby, appointed as Chief Nodal Officer (Water Bodies), I&FC Department. Sh. Saxena will be assisted by Shri T.K. Prijith Rekh, SE(FC-II) for this purpose.

The Chief Nodal Officer is hereby directed to submit the Present Status of the 95 Water Bodies, along with a detailed and accurate Action Plan, comprising comprehensive SOPs for the activities proposed to be taken up in the process of development of the Water Body in pursuance to the proposed timelines. This detailed Status Report and Plan of Action shall be submitted by 14.02.2020 to the NGT appointed MC headed by Justice (Retd.) S.P. Garg.

Further, it is directed that Chief Nodal Officer, along with Sh Prijith Rekh, shall review and monitor the progress of the development work of each of Water Bodies on a fortnightly basis with the EE concerned and submit the progress report thereof by 11.00 am on the following Monday to undersigned. It will be the personal responsibility and accountability of the Chief Nodal Officer and Executive Engineers concerned to ensure that each of the activity with reference to the development of Water Bodies is undertaken strictly within the timelines, so specified in the Action Plan.

Any dereliction on the part of any officer would be viewed seriously and further action, as deemed fit, will be initiated.
