Kuldeep Kohli withdrew his name from the membership of the society and the Managing Committee of the society vide resolution datal 15.01.2012 transferred sole membership in the name of Smt. Arti Jamwal w has made payment towards the land money and construction. The society submitted Schedule VII vide letter dated 10.04.2018 in r/o Smt. Arti Jamv I recommending her case for clearance of members; in Necessary verification of the documents submitted by the member as well - society has already be -done by Sh. M.G. Sathya, AR and the Dealing Asst Since the committee was

Thereafter he filed a writ petition no. 23 3/2016 in the Hon'ble High Court and vide judgment dated 02.04.2018 direction were issued to process the application in accordance with the law without sisting upon the proof residence. Subsequently, the office filed an SLP n 15442/2019 in the Hon'bia Supreme Court against the order dated 02.04.201 of the High Court and violation order dated 29.07.2019 the SLP was dismissed. ... w the claimant Sh. Pada Raj Samrendra has also filed a contempt petition in the Hon'ble High Court vice CCP No. 703/2018. Necessary verification of the documents submitted by the member and the society has been done by Sh. M.L. Gupta, the then AR (Nort) and the Dealing Assistant in accordance with the provisions of DC\$ Act are Rules and the case was recommended for being placed before Rule_St

In the same order pass to by the Hon'ble High Cot 1, the membership of Sh. Gopal Bansal who had also sed a writ petition WP(C) No. 3641/2014 on similar grounds was also directed for consideration of allotment in accordance with law by clubbing the writ petitions of both Sanjay Bajaj and Goral Bansal & decided by a common order dated 28.05. 116. It has been held by the Hon'ble High Court that barring a conviction after ampletion of the proceedings in the duly conducted criminal trial, a member who is merely charge sheet d cannot be precluded from participation in the draw of lots. The case of Sh. Gop it Bansal which is similarly placed, was considered & recommended by the Committee vide minutes dated 04.10.2017.

The society forwarded Schedule VII viril letter dated 27.04.20 3 recommending the name of the petitioner Sh. Sanjay Bajaj for clearance of membership. The documents of the said member of the documents submitted by the society in terms of Schedule VII have been unly verified by Sh. Jitencom Kumar Singh, the then Assistant Registrar and the Dealing Assistant of accordance with the provisions of DCS Act and Rules and the case was recommended for being placed before Rule and Committee meeting.
