1. Short title and commencement :- (i) These rules may be called the "Assistant Prohibition Propaganda officer (Counseling)" Recruitment Rules, 2019.

(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Delhi Gazette.

2. Number of Posts, Classification and level in the pay matrix :- The number of the said post, its classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

Saving :- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions, required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
