ORDER

Whereas, under Schedule-IV (Refer Regulation 2.1.2) of the Food Safety and Standards (Licensing and Registration of Food Businesses) Regulation, 2011 read with regulation 2.1.1 and 2.1.4 of Food Safety and Standards (Licensing and Registration of Food Businesses) Regulations, 2011, the Designated Officer direct the Food Safety Officer to inspect the premises in the manner prescribed by the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India in accordance with these regulations to ensure general sanitary and hygienic conditions as specified in Schedule-IV.

And whereas, while reviewing the process and after due deliberations it is felt that the process of Inspection needs to be made more stakeholder friendly and therefore, the Inspections need to be rationalized and randomized.

Now, therefore, all Designated Officers are hereby directed, to instruct the Food Safety Officers to rationalize the inspections to make it random.

This issues with the prior approval of the Competent Authority.


