1. Brief facts of the complaint

1.1 Sh. Pravesh Kumar has filed a grievance petition before Public Grievances Commission, alleging mis-appropriation of funds in Govt. Higher Secondary School, Joshi Colony, Mandawali, Delhi with the School ID No.1002181, by the Vice Principal of the school. It has been alleged mis-appropriation of funds is in purchases made by the school, amount spent on local tours, funds of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan and the amount of mid day meal.

1.2 The case was closed vide hearing dated 29.02.2016. However, the same has been re-opened now as the complainant's grievance is not resolved till date by the respondent department.

2. Relevant facts emerging during the hearing

2.1 Sh. Rajesh Joshi, ADE (East) and Ms. Neha Shankar, Section Officer, O/o. DDE (East) were present in the hearing and submitted that the

complainant is settling his personal scores against the Vice Principal of the school in the garb of social cause and that the complainant is misusing this forum for settling personal enmity.

3. Directions of the PGC

3.1 The allegations leveled against the Vice Principal of the school by the complainant seem to be motivated by personal grudge. There are different forums, vide which, the complainant can get his grievance resolved and he also has the option to directly approach the respondent department and file his grievance in the Directorate of Education. This Commission is formed to resolve the grievances of individuals who are aggrieved by government department(s) or their actions.

3.2 With these directions, the case stands disposed of.
