

FIRE SAFETY CERTIFICATE

Certified that the **Delhi LPG Bottling Plant located at Ghevra More, Rohtak Road, Tikri Kalan, New Delhi- 110041**, owned/occupied by Indian Oil Corporation Limited, was granted NOC by this department vide letter No. F.6/DFS/MS/89/1745 dated 05.09.1989. The LPG bottling plant was re-inspected by the officers concerned of this department on 03/08/2022 in the presence of Sh. Kiran Kumar Saini, Sr. Manager (LPG Safety) and observed that all the fire prevention and fire safety arrangements provided in the premises found in good working condition and the building/premises have deemed complied with the fire prevention and fire safety requirements in accordance with rule 33 of the Delhi Fire Service Rules, 2010 and provision of OISD 144 and thus the building / premises is fit for occupancy class **“Hazardous (Group – J)”** with effect from 29/08/2022 for a period of three years in accordance with rule 36 unless renewed under rule 37 or sooner cancelled under Rule 40 and subject to compliance of conditions, under rule 38 of the Delhi Fire Service Rules, 2010, printed overleaf.

Conditions for the validity of Fire Safety Certificate:

1. All the fire safety arrangement provided there in shall be maintained in good working conditions at all times.
2. Loss of life or property due to non functional fire safety measure shall be at the responsibility of the management.
3. The trained fire fighting staff should be available round the clock.
4. Any deviation with regard to the construction etc shall be verified by the concerned building sanctioning agency.
5. This certificate cannot be treated in any case for regularizations of unauthorized construction.
6. “The owner / Occupier shall apply for renewal of this Fire Safety Certificate to the Director in Form ‘J’ [sub rule (1) of rule37] along with a copy of this Certificate, six months prior to its expiry”.
7. The owner / occupier shall submit a declaration every year in form “K” provided in the first schedule of Delhi Fire Service Rules 2010. The form is available on www.dfs.Delhigovt.nic.in.
