**Cancellation of Offer of Appointment to the post of PGT (Economics) Male**

Whereas, **Shri MUKESH KUMAR BHARTI**, D.O.B. **18/02/1991**, Roll No. **11310660020** has been nominated by the DSSSB for the post of PGT (Economics) Male against Post Code 66/20 vide letter no. F.4(280)/DSSSB/P&P/2019/52 dated 11/01/2022 vide Result Notice No. 1419 dated 22/12/2021 and accordingly an Offer of Appointment was issued to him vide this Directorate Memorandum No. 553 dated 12/04/2022, the second opportunity was given to him vide reminder-I Memorandum No. 1125 dated 27/05/2022 and Final Opportunity vide Memorandum 2190 dated 06/09/2022.

"An Offer of Appointment should clearly specify the period after which the offer would lapse automatically if the candidate did not join within the specified period. If however, within the specified period, a request is received from the candidate for extension of time, it may be considered by the Ministry/Department but extension beyond three months should not be granted liberally and it may be granted only as an exception where facts and circumstances so warrant and in any case only up to a maximum period of six months from the date of issue of the original offer of an appointment. **An offer of appointment would lapse automatically after the expiry of six months from the date of issue of the original offer of appointment.**

Therefore, In view of the facts and circumstances as above and since the candidate has willfully chosen not to respond to the memorandums dated 12/04/2022, 27/05/2022 and 06/09/2022, the candidature in respect of **Shri MUKESH KUMAR BHARTI** is hereby cancelled and his dossier returned to the DSSSB.
