Implementation of Central Inspection System (CIS) to institutionalize inspections

The Department for Promotion of Internal Industry & Trade (DPIIT), Govt. of India in the State Level Business Reforms Action Plan, 2022 under 'Ease of doing Business' has identified the reform action points as mentioned below termed as 'Inspection Enablers' inter alia in respect of the inspections under Legal Metrology Act, 2009.

With reference to fulfilling the aforementioned reforms suggested by the Department for Promotion of Internal Industry & Trade, Govt. of India, a Central Inspection System (CIS) for undertaking inspections in respect of the Departments concerned has been developed under the aegis of Labour Department, GNCTD with the provision for onboarding of the said CIS Portal by the Weights & Measures Department. The Labour Department has further informed that the 'Central Inspection System' portal cisdel.delhi gov.in has gone live on 05.02.2022 and has further requested to provide the updated/ revised

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Xujm 31/03/2022 list, if any, of the establishments under the Weights and Measures Department along with inspection procedure, inspection checklist and Office Order regarding inspection through Central Inspection System, so that the same may be uploaded on the CIS portal.

Accordingly, the Weights & Measures Department in fulfillment of the reform action points identified by the Department for Promotion of Internal Industry & Trade (DPIIT), Govt. of India under State Level Business Reforms Action Plan, 2022 hereby undertakes compliance of these reform action points by on-boarding the Central Inspection System (CIS) as elaborated hereunder:

Annexure-II

Inspection procedure under Central Inspection System

The Inspection procedure for conduct of inspections under the Central Inspection System (CIS) shall be as under:

- The Central Inspection System (CIS) shall assign/allocate inspection of establishment licensed/registered/functioning under the Weights & Measures Department to Zonal Officer/ Legal Metrology Officer.
- The Establishment concerned shall be notified regarding the inspection so scheduled by way of email/SMS.
- The Zonal Officer/ Legal Metrology Officer visits the site and inspects the Establishment site strictly as per the Inspection checklist (except in case of inspections based on complaints) in a time bound manner.
- The Inspecting Officer prepares and uploads the Inspection Report in prescribed proforma on the Central Inspection System (CIS) within 48 hours.
- The user establishment concerned shall be able to view and download the inspection Report submitted in r/o last 3 years.
- The same Zonal Officer/ Legal Metrology Officer shall not inspect the same establishment twice consecutively.
