ORDER

Whereas, Himachal Pradesh CGHS Ltd. is registered vide Registration No. 1195-GH, Plot No. 21, Sector-05, Dwarka, New Delhi-110041 with this department under the provisions of DCS Act/Rules & Registered Bye-Laws of the society.

And whereas, on the complaint received from Brig. B.C. Rana (Retd.) in a public hearing regarding order of the FC dated 26.07.2022 in revision petition no. 109/2017 requesting that as per law FIR be lodged against the accused person named in the inspection and inquiry report.

And whereas, it was decided that the before proceeding further as the issues involved in the controversy would require inspection of the records of the society and also further scrutiny, the inspection of record u/s 66(1) ordered.

And whereas, vide order dated 31.01.2011 an Inspection Officer under section 61 was appointed to inspect the records of the society in r/o allegations levelled against the then M.C. of the society.

And whereas, the Inspecting Officer appointed under section 61, submitted its report on 12.04.2013. Subsequently, further inquiry under section 66(1) of DCS Act, 2003 was ordered vide order dated 25.07.2013.

And whereas, the then Inquiry Officer recommended that it is difficult to ascertain the exact amount of loss caused by the then M.C of the society. Therefore, while the then Managing Committee is squarely responsible for their decisions or actions leading to the financial loss to the society.

And whereas, vide order dated 02.01.2023 Sh. Rakesh Kohli, Inquiry Officer was appointed under section 66(1) for calculating or ascertain the accurate amount of losses under different heads/civil works so that the then management committee could be proceeded against accordingly.

And whereas, Sh. Rakesh Kohli, Sr. Account Officer is not willing to continue as Inquiry Officer informed vide letter dated 29.03.2023.

Now therefore, I, Satish Kumar Gupta, Assistant Registrar (GH/Sec-III) hereby convey the approval of the Competent Authority to appoint Sh. Ajay Arora, Dy. Secretary (AR Department), as an Inquiry Officer under Section 66(1) of DCS Act, 2003 in Himachal Pradesh CGHS LTD., Plot No. 21, Sector-05, Dwarka, New Delhi-110041 (Regn. No.1195-GH) for calculating or ascertain the accurate amount of losses under different heads/civil works so that the then management committee could be proceeded accordingly.

The Inquiry Officer will be paid Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) as Honorarium from the society's funds.

The inquiry shall be completed within a period of 60 days of issue of this order.
