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**Report of State Fee Regulatory Committee regulating Fee Structure of privately managed Self-financed Institutions offering different courses.**

The Govt. of Delhi vide Notification No. F.DHE-4(45)/2007-08/6962 dated 04.04.2008 constituted a Committee for regulating the fee structure of Privately Managed Institutions offering different courses in the National Capital Territory of Delhi. The Composition of the Committee is as follows:-

The report of Justice Usha Mehra Committee issued vide letter dated 11.06.2007 and the recommendations dated 03.07.2008 of the present State Fee Regulatory Committee have observed that since at the time of submitting the report and recommendations, the impact of the Sixth Pay Commission's recommendations were not known, there is, therefore, the need for separate orders / recommendations to accommodate the Pay Commission's recommendations; consequently re-fixing the fee structure.

With the NCT of Delhi Government and the Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University accepting the Sixth Pay Commission and its modifications, it has necessitated fresh recommendations on the fee to be collected from the students of the University/ Board of Technical Education, hence, the fresh recommendations are as mentioned below.

While making recommendations on the fee structure, the Committee felt that the occasion should be used to address some of the concerns raised by Justice Usha Mehra Committee about the academic atmosphere prevailing in many of the institutions affiliated to the University and also to prescribe a uniform format for maintaining accounts by the institutions.

Therefore, the committee issued two proformae. One, on Academic, Administration and Infrastructural aspects covering 28 parameters and the other, on Financial aspects. These two proformae were circulated to all institutions for their comments. The Associations representing these institutions and some institutions themselves sent their comments and some

also appeared before the Committee to present their views. After considering their views, the committee modified the proforma (Annexure 'A' & 'B') and circulated to all the institutions for providing information to the Committee on the prescribed formats.

The Committee after receiving information from almost all these institutions felt an opportunity to be given to all these institutions to explain and clarify certain deficiencies noticed in their replies and graded them into A+, A, B and C categories. A+ being the highest grading.

As far as the financial format is concerned the following deficiencies were observed:

1. In almost all the cases the Institutes have not made disclosures regarding payments/ benefits to the persons having substantial interest.

A. Persons having the substantial interest were defined in note attached to financial format. Definition of persons having the substantial interest is reproduced below:

- a) The author of the trust or the founder of the institution;
- b) Any person who has made a substantial contribution to the trust or institution, that is to say, any persons whose total contribution up to the end of the relevant previous year exceeds Five Lacs Rupees;
- c) Where such author, founder or person is a Hindu undivided family, a member of the family;
- d) Any trustee of the trust or manager (by whatever name called) of the institution;
- e) Any relative of any such author founder, person, member, trustee or manager as aforesaid;
- f) Any concern in which any of the persons referred to in clauses (a), (b), (c), (d) and (e) has a substantial interest.

For the purpose of clause (e) above relative means

- (i) Spouse of the person specified in clause viii (a to d)
- (ii) Brother or sister of the person specified in clause viii (a to d)
- (iii) Brother or sister of the spouse of the person specified in clause viii (a to d)
- (iv) Brother or sister of either of the parents of the person specified in clause viii (a to d)
- (v) Any lineal ascendant or descendant of the person specified in clause viii (a to d).
- (vi) Any lineal ascendant or descendant of the spouse of the person specified in clause viii (a to d)
- (vii) Spouse of the person referred to in clause (ii) to (iv).

2. Specific reason for increase in Unreasonable and Excessive High Expenses were not mentioned by the Institutes.

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3. In some of the cases the Institutes did not even care for arithmetical accuracy.
4. Interest paid on loan for acquiring Land and Building has been charged by the Institute whereas Land and Building is not appearing in the Institute's Balance Sheet.
5. Expenses/ Adjusted Expenses (Adjustment in expenses were made only in case where the Institute has not explained the reasons for Unreasonable and Excessive Expense in comparison to previous year figures), per student per annum was less than the fee charged by the Institute in most of the cases except a few. In cases where the Institute failed to furnish the reasons for unreasonable and excessive high expense adjustments were made on best judgement on the basis of data and other information available on record.
6. In almost all the cases the Institutes have not furnished the Audit Report as per the requirement of the Format given by the Committee.
7. Quite a few number of Institutes have not mentioned the year to which the Statement of Accounts relates.
8. As far as the academic and administrative aspects were concerned, there were certain discrepancies relating to how they have been graded by other organizations/ agencies, certain infrastructure facilities and a few academic members.

**In pursuance to Proviso to Section 6 (2) of the Delhi Professional Colleges or Institutions (Prohibition of Capitation Fee, Regulation of Admission, Fixation of Non- exploitative Fee and Other Measures to Ensure Equity and Excellence) Act 2007, notices for personal hearing were issued to the Institutes.**

The institutes individually and independently appeared before the Committee as per detail given in the Annexure – 'C'.

After taking into consideration their clarifications and explanations, the committee finally graded them. The grading was informed to the individual institutions personally on the date of hearing. The list showing the grading is given in the Annexure 'D'.

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

The Committee recommends increase in the fee structure for the academic year 2009-10 & onwards as per detail mentioned below:-

S.N.	Grade of the Institute	% of Fee hike	Base Year
1.	A+	30%	Over the base year 2008-09
2.	A	25%	-do-
3	B	20%	-do-
4.	C	15%	-do-

The fee structure will absorb 5% increase given to institutions at the 3<sup>rd</sup> year of various courses.

Interest payable on loan borrowed from bank for the purpose of acquiring land from DDA in auction and constructing the Building on it on or after 2006, be deemed as Capital Expenditure. The total interest on loan payable during the currency of term loan but excluding the penal interest and other charges if any be amortized over a period of 20 years in equal amount and the cost of land acquired in auction on or after 2006, be the amortized over a period of 30 years. These two amortizations are relevant only for the purpose of calculation of fee structure and not for any other purpose. The above amortization benefit shall be available to the Institute only if such Capital Asset (Land and Building) are acquired on or after 2006 and shown in the Institute's Balance Sheet and not in the Trust/ Society managing such Institute.

After compliance of these guidelines / conditions, the concerned institute may apply giving full detail of loan in question and interest on it for consideration of these two items by the Committee and for passing appropriate orders in this regard.


The fee structure recommended as given in Annexure 'E' will be valid for the academic session 2009-10 & 2010-11 and a hike of 5% has been recommended for the students to be admitted to the various courses during the academic session 2011-12.


New institutions which come into operation during the academic year 2009-10 will be given a hike in the fee structure on the base fee as is applicable to Grade- 'C' institutions (i.e. 15% hike of base fee).


The committee also takes this opportunity to recommend to the Department of Higher Education and the Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University / Board of Technical Education for bringing about improvement in the following areas:

- a) In respect of the institutions which have not furnished information, action as appropriate under the Act, should be initiated by the Department of Higher Education, GNCT of Delhi.
- b) Academic excellence should be the focus and concern; of all Government, Universities and the Fee Committee. There is necessity of ensuring that the faculty attend at least one workshop in a year relating to their subject. The Institute should conduct the seminars and workshops which have to be made mandatory taking into account their size and capacity. In case one institution is not able to conduct the workshop / seminars, a group of them should be encouraged to organize Workshops/ Seminars.
- c) The faculty should publish research and seminars papers which should be reviewed by appropriate agencies.


- d) .Research to be encouraged and well rewarded by the University.
- e) The institutes should provide consultancy particularly to SME's. For this, it may be necessary that the University have to conduct training workshops.
- f) Institutes should be encouraged to publish newsletters, institutional magazines.
- g) As there is a shortage of good faculty, it may be necessary to encourage institutions which have been graded A to have video conferencing facility with other institutes which do not have good faculty. The University may devise ways & means to help these institutes to set-up Video Conferencing facilities by providing necessary financial incentives. These institutes should become mentoring institutes for less endowed ones.
- h) The committee has observed that many institutes have not provided any scholarship/ fellowship to the meritorious. Fortunately, the Government of Delhi has initiated a scholarship scheme. It is hoped that this scheme will support only the meritorious and will not be routinised on the basis of other considerations.



Any item under which the expenses exceeds 5% of the total revenue or rupees 5,000 whichever is higher shall be shown as a separate & distinct item against an appropriate head in Income & Expenditure account and shall not be combined with any other item to be shown under miscellaneous expenses.
- viii) Give reason for substantial increase in expense in comparison to previous year corresponding figures.
- ix) The Income & Expenditure Account shall be in the form set out above or as near, thereto, as circumstances permit.
