<u>Guidelines for granting Financial Assistance to the students</u> of professional courses under the State Universities of Delhi.

As per notification dated 29.05.2007 of Govt. of NCT of Delhi, 'The Delhi Professional Colleges or Institutions (Prohibition of Capitation Fee, Regulation of Admission, Fixation of Non-Exploitative Fee and Other Measures to Ensure Equity & Excellence) Act, 2007' under section 15 of the said Act, the Govt. has to constitute a Fund to be called 'The Higher Education Scholarship Fund', for providing scholarship to the socially and economically backward students admitted in the institutions, on merit-cum-means basis. Govt. of NCT of Delhi has constituted a 'Delhi Higher Education Aid Trust' inter-alia for the administration of the Higher Education Scholarship Fund, under the Chairpersonship of Hon'ble Chief Minister, Delhi.

A. Funds of the Society

The Govt. of NCT of Delhi may contribute an amount of Rs. 1 Crore as first time contribution, and such amounts as may be necessary from time to time.

GGSIP University will collect & deposit 25% of the amount (or any other amount so prescribed by the Government), collected by the self-financing institutions as tuition fee from the students admitted in 2nd shift every year, till the course is completed.

The Govt. would encourage corporate sector to donate money for this fund by facilitating Income Tax Exemption for Corporate donations.

Objectives of the Scheme :-B.

Objectives of the scheme to be called 'YUVA NIRMAN', would be to provide financial assistance to the socially and economically backward students for granting Financial Assistance, initially to the students of professional courses under State Universities of Delhi.

Scholarship/Re-imbursement:-C.

Scholarship / re-imbursement of half the tuition fee fixed by the University, for Higher Education would be granted to the students whose parental annual income i.e. family income from all sources is categorized as mentioned below:-

<i>S.N.</i>	Category	Family Income from all sources
1.	'A'	Rs.0 to Rs. 1,00,000/-
2.	'B'	Rs. 1,00,001 to Rs. 2,50,000/-
3.	'C'	Rs. 2,50,001 to Rs. 4,50,000/-

The scholarship will be sanctioned to the candidates of the Income category category 'B' and lastly category 'C' in order of preference, if funds are 'A', available. In case of same category, precedence should be given to the merit.

Other eligibility conditions are as given below:-

- The student should have secured 60% marks with no back papers and 1. 70% attendance.
- Student should be domicile of Delhi. 2.
- The eligible student may apply to the Principal/Director of the 3. concerned university/college/institute in prescribed format.

Govt. of NCT of Delhi oth Mara The concerned University/College/Institute have to constitute a Committee of atleast three officers at their own level to scrutinize the applications and the same after scrutiny be submitted to Director/Principal of the said University/College/Institute, who will forward the same with his/her recommendation to the Director, Higher Education, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, 5 Sham Nath Marg, Delhi-110 054 alongwith the following documents:-

- i) Income certificate from the concerned Revenue Officer.
- *ii)* Attested copy of the Mark Sheet of the last examination passed.
- iii) Attendance Record.

iv) Certificate of Delhi Domicile

Directorate of Higher Education will provide services to the Trust till it has its own secretarial staff. Member-Secretary or authorized officer of the Trust would operate the funds of the Trust as per the Policies / Guidelines laid down by the Trust.
