Sir,

This has reference to your online I. D. No. 2020122409196 dated 28.12.2020 on the subject cited above. In this connection this is to inform you that the above mentioned premise was visited by the officer concerned of this department on 13.01.2021 in the presence of Mr. Pankaj (Manager) to verify the fire safety arrangements as stipulated in NBC Part 4 and as well installed in the building. During the course of inspection it has observed that the building/ premise is comprised of basement, ground & 03 upper floors (Restaurant at ground floor only). Your request for FSC is rejected under Rule 37 (3) due to following shortcomings.

- 1 There are three exit doors having width of 1.90m, 1.20m & 1.10m provided against requirements of 02m & 1.50m. The second exit door is also not qualifying the requirement of safe means of escape as this escape route is through the kitchen area of the restaurant.
- 2 Fire extinguisher provided in the building were checked and found not working at the time of inspection.
- 3 Hose reel hose provided but not functional.
- 4 MOEFA System provided but found not functional.
- 5 Internal hydrants provided but not functional. Hose boxes not provided.
- 6 Terrace pumps capacity of 450lpm provided but not functional. The pumps are not on auto mode.
- 7 Terrace level fire water tank capacity of 10,000ltrs provided against the requirement of 20,000ltr.
- 8 Exit signage's not provided in the building.
- 9 Standby power supply not provided.

Keeping in view of above Fire Safety Certificate cannot be considered at this stage. You may apply again on form 'I' as stipulated in sub rule (2) 35 of rules, DFS Rules 2010 after compliance of the shortcoming mention above.
