NOTIFICATION

Dated the *11/1/12*

No F.12(15)Fin(Rev-I)/2011-12. In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 22 of the Delhi Tax on Luxuries Act 1996, (Delhi Act 10 of 1996) as amended by the Delhi Tax on Luxuries (Amendment) Act, 2000 (Delhi Act 6 of 2000), the Lt. Governor of National Capital Territory of Delhi, being satisfied that it is necessary to do so in the public interest, hereby exempt the following persons or class of persons from payment of Luxury Tax on the Luxury provided in the Hotels during 2<sup>nd</sup> September, 2011 to 12<sup>th</sup> September, 2011 with check in on the 2<sup>nd</sup> September, 2011 and check out on the 12<sup>th</sup> September, 2011 (ten days) in the National Capital Territory of Delhi, namely: -

Delegates/Guests/Participants of the Pacific Asia Travel Association (PATA) Travel Mart, 2011, organized in New Delhi during 6<sup>th</sup> - 9<sup>th</sup> September, 2011 followed by the PATA Board of Directors' Meeting from 10<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> September, 2011, by the Ministry of Tourism, Government of India.

The exemption is granted subject to the following conditions: -

1. The Ministry of Tourism, Government of India shall provide to the Department of Luxury Tax, Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi the list of delegates/guests/participants for the Pacific Asia Travel Association (PATA) Travel Mart, 2011 hotel wise and room wise, furnishing therewith the details about duration of stay, type of room and tariff charged by the hotel.
2. The Ministry of Tourism, Government of India shall issue certificates to the respective hotels along with the list of Delegates/Guests/Participants for the Pacific Asia Travel Association (PATA) Travel Mart, 2011 hotel wise and room wise, furnishing therewith the details about duration of stay, type of room and tariff entitled for exemption by this notification.
3. The respective hotels in turn shall enclose the certificates along with the aforesaid list issued by the Ministry of Tourism, Government of India and the copies of the bills raised by the hotels with their Luxury Tax Returns in form-8 for the month of September, 2011. The respective hotels shall also furnish the turnover on accommodation provided to the Guests/Delegates/Participants attending the Pacific Asia Travel Association (PATA) Travel Mart, 2011 in column 1(B) of Form-8 as prescribed under Delhi Tax on Luxuries Rules, 1996 for the month of September, 2011 while claiming exemption from payment of Luxury Tax on the basis of the notification.
