NOTIFICATION

Delhi, the 5th December, 2014

No. F.7(190)12/DoFS/Admin/8973-82.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India read with Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification F.27/59-Him(i), dated 13th July, 1959, and in supersession of the notification No. F.2(15)/78-S.II, dated the 4th May, 1978 regarding the recruitment rules, in so far as they relate to the post of Chemist in the Department of Food Safety, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Lt. Governor of National Capital Territory of Delhi, with the prior approval of the Union Public Service Commission, is pleased to frame following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Chemist in the Department of Food Safety, Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(i) These rules may be called the Department of Food Safety, Chemist Recruitment Rules, 2014.
(ii) They shall come in force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Number of Posts, Classification and Scale of Pay.**—The number of post, their classification and Pay band, Grade pay/scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in column 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. **Method of Recruitment, Age Limit, Qualification, etc.**—The method of recruitment of the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matter relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.
4. **Disqualifications.**— No person,-
 (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
 (b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person,
 shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:
 Provided that the Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
5. **Power to Relax.**— Where the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
6. **Saving.**— Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government of National Territory of Delhi from time to time in this regard.
