## NOTIFICATION

Delhi, the 31st December, 2014

**No. F. 7(189)/12/DoFS/Admn/9317-9326.**—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the constitution read with Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification F. 27/59-Him(i) dated the 13th July, 1959, and in supersession of notification No. F. 4(96)/04/PFA/Admin. dated the 7th December, 2006 regarding Recruitment Rules to the post of Public Analyst in Directorate of Prevention of Food Adulteration in the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Lt. Governor of National Capital Territory of Delhi, with the prior approval of the Union Public Service Commission, is please to make the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Food Analyst in Department of Food Safety, Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi, namely:—

1. **Short title and Commencement.**—(i) These rules may be called the Department of Food Safety, Food Analyst Recruitment Rules, 2014.  
(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Number of Posts, Classification and Pay band and Grade pay/ Scale of Pay.**—The number of post, their classification and Pay band and Grade pay/ scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. **Method of Recruitment, Age Limit, Qualification, etc.**—The method recruitment of the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matter relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.
4. **Disqualifications.**—No person,—  
 a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or  
 b) Who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person,  
 shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:  
 Provided that the Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing exempted any person from the operation of this rule.
5. **Power to Relax.** — Where the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
6. **Saving.** — Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

(b) Any person who is a Public Analyst under the provisions of Prevention of Food Adulteration Act, 1954 on the date of commencement of these rules may hold office of the Food Analyst subject to the terms and
