A PERSON HAVING BEING APPOINTED AS FOOD INSPECTOR HAVING QUALIFICATION PRESCRIBED UNDER THE P.F.A RULE, 1955 OR AS LOCAL HEALTH AUTHORITY SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR APPOINTMENT AS DESIGNATED OFFICER SUBJECT TO FULFILLING SUCH OTHER CONDITIONS AS MAY BE PRESCRIBED FOR THE POST OR DESIGNATED OFFICER BY THE STATE GOVERNMENT.

NOTE : WHERE JUNIORS WHO HAVE COMPLETED THEIR QUALIFYING / ELIGIBILITY SERVICE ARE BEING CONSIDERED FOR PROMOTION, THEIR SENIORS WOULD ALSO BE CONSIDERED PROVIDED THEY ARE NOT SHORT OF SUCH QUALIFYING / ELIGIBILITY SERVICE BY MORE THAN HALF OF LESS, AND HAVE SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED THEIR PROBATION PERIOD FOR PROMOTION TO THE NEXT HIGHER GRADE ALONGWITH THEIR JUNIOR WHO HAVE ALREADY COMPLETED SUCH QUALIFYING / ELIGIBILITY SERVICE.

NOTE : FOR THE PURPOSE OF COMPUTING MINIMUM QUALIFYING SERVICE FOR PROMOTION, THE SERVICE RENDERED ON A REGULAR BASIS BY AN OFFICER PRIOR TO 1/12/2004/ THE DATE FROM WHICH THE REVISED PAY STRUCTURE BASED ON THE 6TH CPC RECOMMENDATION HAS BEEN EXTENDED, SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE SERVICE RENDERED IN THE CORRESPONDING PAY SCALE EXTENDED BASED ON THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE PAY COMMISSION.
